**FAITH CORNER:**



**KNOWING YOUR FAITH – Why does the Mass also instruct us?**

**The Mass instructs us in points of the faith, because the Church hopes to teach even as she helps to sanctify us.** The Liturgy of the

Word during Mass is a chief source of Catechetical instruction or teachings on the faith. The unfolding of the liturgical year instructs, uplifts, and forms Catholics by bringing them into relationship with the person of our Savior through the actualization of successive events in the life of Christ from His eagerly awaited birth at Christmas through His wonderful life as Mystical Head poured out at Pentecost through the action of the Holy Spirit even now acting in His Church.

We will profit more spiritually from the ineffable riches the Lord has placed at our disposal in the Liturgy of the Holy Mass when we know, love, and live it more wholeheartedly. The best way to do so is by participating fully, consciously, and actively in that bountiful liturgy.

**What are the main parts of the "Liturgy of the Word" at Mass? The "Liturgy of the Word" is the first major part of Mass. It includes: a) the Old and New Testaments as well as a Responsorial Psalm--God's Word listened to; b) Homily--God's Word explained; c) Profession of Faith (or Creed)--God's Word accepted and held fast; d) Universal Prayer (or Prayer of the Faithful)--God's Word appealed to.** In the readings, and especially the Gospel, Christ is present to His people in His Word.
