KNOWING YOUR FAITH – What are the astoundingly great effects of our receiving of Holy Communion? The astounding effects of receiving Holy Communion are: a) that it brings us into the closest union with our Lord and increases sanctifying grace within us; b) that it reduces our inclination toward evil

and gives us the desire and strength to lead good Catholic lives;

c) that it remits venial sins and guards against mortal ones; d) and that it is a pledge of our future resurrection and blessedness in heaven. *"Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the day"* (Jn 6:54). A person who would receive Communion unworthily and knowingly in unconfessed serious sin would not gain its benefits and, in fact, would sin by a sacrilege which, however, can be forgiven in a sincere confession.
