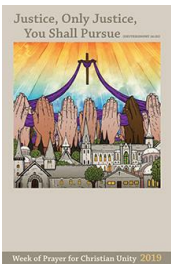

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS

THE SACRAMENT OF THE GREAT GIFTS TO OUR PRIESTS – How do we know for certain that Jesus Christ instituted the Sacrament of Holy Orders? We know that Jesus Christ instituted the Sacrament of Holy Orders a) from Sacred Scripture b) and from the constant teaching of the Church throughout her entire history. Christ our Lord Himself bestowed on the Apostles the grace and the powers of His sacred Priesthood at the Last Supper, and afterward the Apostles also handed on this power to others as priests. *“I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God that is within you through the laying on of my hands” (2Tim 1:6).* The Apostles understood their office as a priestly one, as a participation in the very priesthood of Jesus Christ. Primarily, this office of the priests consists in building up the Church, by continuing the priestly mission of Christ in word, in Sacraments, and in being a living example. In this sense every priest is a representative of Christ, and this position has great significance especially for celebrating the Holy Eucharist.
