**BULLYING AWARENESS AND PREVENTION WEEK NOVEMBER 19-25, 2017**

During Bullying Awareness and Prevention Week, students, school staff and parents are encouraged to learn more about bullying and its effect on student learning and well-being. Bullying is defined as a form of repeated, persistent and aggressive behavior directed at an individual or individuals that is intended to cause (or should be known to cause) fear and distress and/or harm to another person's body, feelings, self-esteem or reputation. Bullying occurs in a context where there is a real or perceived power imbalance. Schools are encouraged to use this opportunity to explain the different forms bullying can take. These include: **Physical** – hitting, shoving, stealing or damaging property **Verbal** – name calling, mocking, or making sexist, racist or homophobic comments **Social** – excluding others from a group or spreading gossip or rumours about them **Electronic** – (commonly known as **cyberbullying**) – spreading rumours and hurtful comments through the use of cellphones, e-mail, text messaging and social networking sites For information and resources, visit the TCDSB Bullying Awareness and Prevention <https://www.tcdsb.org/ProgramsServices/SafeSchools/BullyingAwarenessAndPrevention/Pages/default.aspx>
