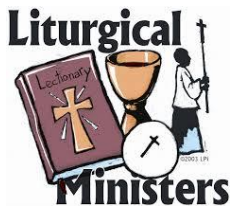

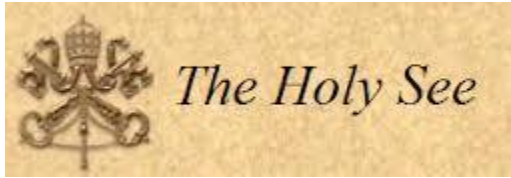
For those who missed our first meeting October 17th, another meeting is scheduled for **Saturday November 14th at 1:00 p.m.**

Inter Mirifica("Among wonderful inventions") is the Decree on the Instruments of Social Communication which was promulgated on December 5, 1963. Although this decree was written over fifty years ago and was primarily addressing cinema, radio, television and newspapers, it contains wisdom applicable

today. "If these media are properly used they can be of considerable benefit to mankind" however the church "grieves with a mother's sorrow at the harm all too often inflicted upon society by their misuse" (n2). The council urged that proper and ethical use of media be part of the school curriculum (n16). The council fathers recognised that the decree was a starting platform for this issue and recommended that a pastoral instruction be drawn up " with the help of experts from various countries" to further the work on social communication (n23). This was published in 1971 (Communio et Progressio)(CP) and offers it own advice "Simple entertainment has a value of its own but----recipients should exercise self-control----so as not to be so beguiled by the charms of the media's products or by the curiosity that these arouse that they neglect urgent duties or simply waste time (CPn52). Parents and educators are urged to encourage children to develop "a keen critical faculty and a sense of personal responsibility based on sound morality" (CP n67). The final paragraph ends with "The People of God walk in history. As they who are --both communicators and recipients advance with their times they look forward with confidence and even with enthusiasm to whatever the development of communication in a space age may have to offer" (CP n187).
