## The Holy See

### **Gravissimum Educationis (The seriousness of education).**

The Declaration on Christian Education was promulgated on 28 October 1965. In this declaration the bishops lay out some basic principles of education but ask that they be used as a starting point for further dialogue (preface). "--children and young people ---should be trained to acquire gradually a more perfect sense of responsibility in the proper development of their own lives--. As they grow older they should receive a positive and prudent education in matters relating to sex". They should be trained in the necessary and useful skills so as to be able to participate actively in the life of society (n1). The role of parents in the education of their children is paramount. It is the duty of parents to "create a family atmosphere inspired by love and devotion to God and their fellow men which will promote an integrated, personal and social education of their children (n3). The bishops praise the teaching profession stating that it is a vocation that is "Splendid and of the highest importance" in helping parents carry out their duties (n5).
