The Marygrove Camp is a residential camp situated on Georgian Bay, near Penetang, Ontario. Open to eligible girls ages 5 – 13, Marygrove provides an 8 day camping experience for children who may not otherwise have the opportunity to enjoy a camping adventure. Families who are experiencing financial or domestic hardship may contact the Society to determine their eligibility. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul, Toronto Central Council, helps over 1,000 girls each summer, registering eligible campers through home visits. ## **FAITH CORNER:**



### **KNOWING YOUR FAITH – What is the Holy Eucharist?**

The Holy Eucharist is the Sacrament of the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ truly present under the appearances of the consecrated bread and wine. Jesus offers Himself on the altar as our sacrifice and to give Himself to us as our sacrificial food for strength in Holy Communion. The changing of bread and wine into Christ's Sacred Body and Blood is known as transubstantiation. The Holy Eucharist is both a memorial and here-and-now celebration of the Lord's Passion, Death, and glorious Resurrection. Through, with, in, and by the Church, Christ's redemptive sacrifice on the Cross becomes present again in every celebration of the Holy Mass, Jesus promised to give us the Holy Eucharist in His words, *"The bread that I will give is My flesh, for the life of the world. Then the Jews started to argue among themselves, saying, 'How can this man give us His flesh to eat?' Jesus said to them, 'Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. For My flesh is real food, and My blood is real drink'" (Jn 6:51-55)*

In its Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, Vatican Council II says, *"At the Last Supper, on the night when He was betrayed, our Savior instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of His body and blood. He did this in order to perpetuate the sacrifice of the Cross throughout the centuries until He should come again, and so to entrust to His beloved spouse, the Church, a memorial of His death and Resurrection: a Sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a paschal banquet in which Christ is eaten, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us"*.
