Marriage Guidelines

Marriage Celebration with Eucharist: Couples need to be both practicing Catholics. Which means they attend Sunday mass every Sunday. **Please note there are no exceptions.** Couples are also encouraged to receive the Sacrament of Confession prior to Wedding Ceremony. Confessions at St. Ambrose are every Saturday 3:45pm to 4:15pm.

Marriage Celebration with No Mass: Marriage Ceremony without the Eucharist means either one of the couples are not Catholic or couple are not attending mass regularly.

Choosing Readings Selections can be found on parish website: www.stambroseparish.com

- Select 1st Reading from the “Old Testament” – 1st Reader
- Select 2nd Reading from the “New Testament” – 2nd Reader (Optional)
- Gospel – chosen and read by celebrant Priest
- Select General Intercessions – 3rd Reader

Once you have chosen your readings, please provide an enlarged copy of each reading, with the name of the reader to the priest at your rehearsal. (Please see attached sample copy).

Parents are encouraged to do the following:

- Parents of bride to walk her down main aisle. If you wish the traditional in which father escorts the bride, then someone should be delegated to walk the mother of the bride.
- Parents of the groom are to take their place in the front pew or parents of the groom can be walked down the aisle by groom prior to wedding party procession. Please note priest conducts all rehearsals.

Dress Code

- Bride and matrons should dress **discreetly**.

Unity Candle

- Unity candles are discouraged and are not part of the ceremony. We suggested having it at your reception.

Flowers

- Flowers should be delivered approximately ½ hour before the time of the wedding ceremony.
- Aisle runner / carpet is discouraged because guests can trip. Also flower peddles scattered on the aisle are discouraged because someone can slip. In addition, please no rice or confetti outside church.
- You may wish to give your mothers (grandmothers) a **red** rose at the Sign of Peace. Please tell your florist not to dress the rose for it should be visible. Many times it has so much extra added to it, including a plastic wrapping that the rose is totally covered. A simple water capsule at the base of the stem is enough as to keep it fresh.

Proper Behaviour in Church

- Please **do not chew gum**. Ushers are asked to help in ensuring that when guests enter the church chewing gum, that they dispose of it in the waste bin in the bathroom. Also, if guests are chewing gum they are not to receive Holy Communion.
- Cellular phones should not be used in the church and we kindly ask that they be turned off upon entering the church.
- Loud talking in the entrance and body of the church is strongly discouraged. St. Ambrose parish is a place of prayer and worship, so silence is observed. Upon entering the church, we remind you that you are entering a “Holy Sanctuary” where the Blessed Sacrament is present. Also, there may be others in church whom may be praying- please show respect.

TIME

- Groom and ushers should be at the church ½ hour before the time of the ceremony.

- Bride and matrons should be at church 10 minutes before the time of the ceremony. Punctuality is a **must** for there are usually 2 weddings per weekend. Please respect other people's times and also the celebrant.

Music

- We kindly ask that you support our music ministry and not hire other musicians / singers for your wedding. Every parish has its own musicians. Please call Greg Furmanczyk to set up a time to meet with him regarding music for your wedding day. Payment for the services is to be arranged directly with Greg. Greg is the organist and is accompanied by a soloist. Their services are \$150.00 each. Should you wish to book other musicians (singers, trumpet, violin, etc.), you must get approval from the parish priest and speak with Greg afterwards.

Marriage License

- You are to obtain a Marriage License approximately 2 ½ months before your date of marriage from any municipal center close to you. The fee for this document is \$125.00. This document is issued “on the spot” upon presentation of **either** a birth certificate or a valid passport for both parties.
- Only one party needs to go to obtain the application. In this case, you need to download the application from the Government of Ontario website, www.cbs.gov.on.ca, have your fiancée complete and sign their portion of the application and provide the appropriate documentation.
- Once you have obtained your license, **please contact the parish office** to set-up an appointment to complete Form I with Father Donatello. This is approximately a ½ hour meeting.
- The meeting usually takes place 2 ½ months before your wedding. Also, please bring the names and complete addresses of your Best Man and Matron of Honour to this meeting. At this time a rehearsal time will be set. We usually have rehearsals at 6:00 or 7:00PM, on either Monday, or Wednesday evenings. **PLEASE BE ON TIME.**

- With your marriage license, you will also receive an Application for a Request for Marriage or Death Certificates. This application needs to be completed following your marriage and mailed to the Office of the Registrar General along with payment. In turn, you will receive a Marriage Certificate, which you will need to make any changes of Name on your Driver's License and other legal forms. A copy of this application is included for you with the package.

Wedding planners are not permitted. All weddings arrangements and liturgy selections and wedding rehearsals are to be made directly with Father Donatello.

Wedding Fee

To conclude, the parish finance committee kindly asks that you give **\$350.00** for the rendered and use of the church for your wedding. This includes the administrative work to be done to prepare proper documents/license for the wedding. Musicians and flowers are not included in the wedding fee.
