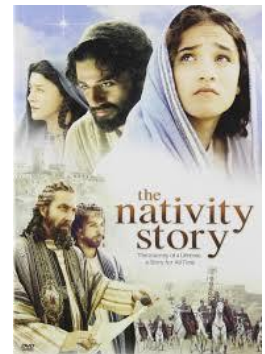
St. Ambrose Parish Advent Movie Matinee

CANDLELIGHT MEMORIAL MASS

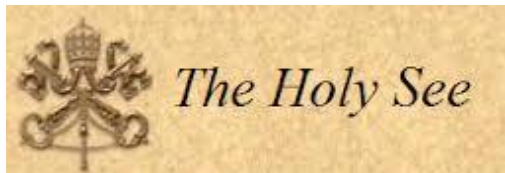

Perfectae Caritatis (Perfect Love) is the Decree on the Up to Date Renewal of Religious Life which was promulgated on 28 October 1965. The decree calls for religious orders to return to "the sources of the whole of the Christian life" and, in seeking spiritual renewal adapt "to the changed conditions of our time"(n2). One adaptation refers to the

religious habit. For both men and women, in addition to being simple and modest, the habit "must be in keeping with the requirements of health --suited to the times and place and to the needs of the apostolate" (n17). Another adaptation recommended is the proper revision of "constitutions-- books of customs--prayers --ceremonies" with obsolete prescriptions being suppressed and brought into line with conciliar documents(n3). Superiors of religious institutions should provide opportunities for continuing education so as to facilitate ongoing development of spiritual, doctrinal and technical culture (n18). Sister Margaret Brennan Ph.D. of the order of the Immaculate Heart of Mary writes that the encouragement by the council for education of the religious orders was well received by the religious women in the USA as there had already been a significant move in that direction with American women religious. Sister Madeleva Wolff C.S.C. founded the first graduate school of theology for women at St Mary's College, Notre Dame, Indiana in 1943 (Brennan p.42).
