Join Toronto Right to Life for a Special Pro-Life Presentation

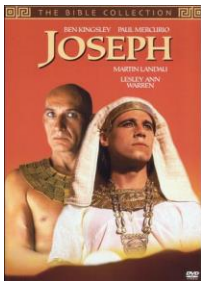
Toronto Right to Life (TRTL) provides pro-life education to schools, churches and community groups throughout Toronto and the GTA.

ASH WEDNESDAY – March 1st Masses will be celebrated at 8:00AM & 7:30PM, ashes will be distributed at both masses. The Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday beginning **Friday March 3rd** until **Good Friday April 14th** at 7:00PM.

DAYS OF PENANCE DURING LENT – The time of Lent and all Fridays of the year are, throughout the universal Church, days and times especially appropriate for spiritual exercises; penitential liturgies; pilgrimages as signs of penance; voluntary self denial, such as fasting and almsgiving. Abstinence from meat (or some other food) or another penitential practice, according to the prescriptions of the conference of bishops, is to be observed on each Friday of the year unless it is a solemnity. Fast and abstinence from meat are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. All persons who have completed their fourteenth year are bound by the law of abstinence. All adults (eighteen years or older) are bound by the law of fast up to the beginning of their sixtieth year. Pastors and parents are to see to it that minors who are not bound by a law of fast or abstinence are educated nevertheless in an authentic sense of penance. It is for the conference of bishops to determine more precisely the observance of fast and abstinence and to substitute in whole or in part for fast or abstinence other forms of penance, especially works of charity and exercises of piety and missionary works.
