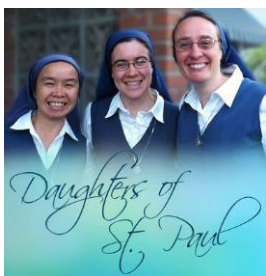
**BIRTHRIGHT – AN INTERNATIONAL PREGNANCY SERVICE**
