THE MARIAN LAMP AND SANCTUARY LAMP ARE IN NEED OF INTENTIONS

The Marian (Blue) Lamp and the Sanctuary (Red) Lamp burns for seven days and are intended to be burnt as a votive offering in an act of Christian prayer. We can offer this **act of prayer** for the faithful departed or for a living intention. The usage of votive candles or lamps is a pious practice in many churches. The symbolism does remind us that prayer is a "coming into" the light of Christ, allowing our souls to be filled with His light, and letting that light burn on in our souls even though we may return to our other activities. FAITH CORNER:



KNOWING YOUR FAITH – When do Priests change the bread into Christ's Sacred Body and the wine into His Precious Blood? By the words of consecration, the priest changes the bread into the sacred Body of Jesus and the wine into His precious Blood. After the consecration of the bread the priest holds the sacred Host aloft and

then after he consecrates the wine he does the same with the chalice of the precious Blood so that we may adore Christ, our Lord. Gazing at the sacred Host and chalice, we may well offer a silent prayer, such as: "O Sacrament most holy O Sacrament divine, All praise and all thanksgiving Be every moment Thine." Or we may simply gaze upon the consecrated species believingly while adoring silently and praying. "My Lord and my God!"
