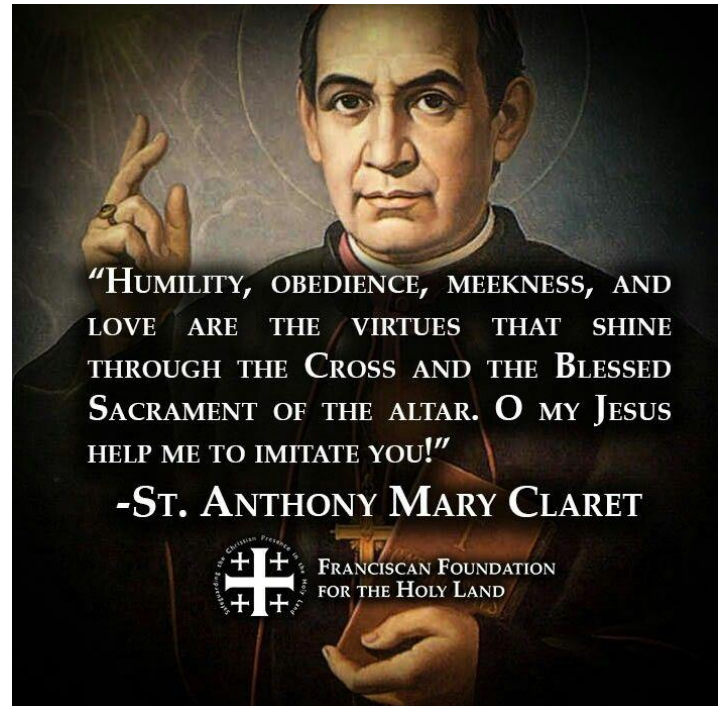

SECURITIES AS A CHERITABLE GIFT OPTION



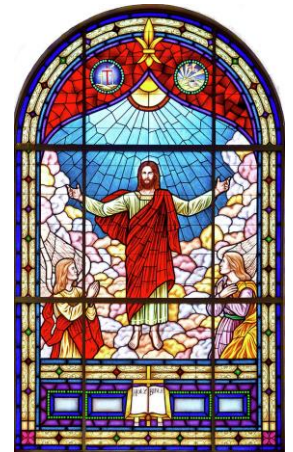

Growing Your Prayer Life

As Catholics, we know that our hearts are made for prayer. The spiritual wisdom of the many Saints before us can help us in our own prayerful journeys, giving us much needed encouragement if we tend to struggle with daily prayer. Reading about the (often) very turbulent lives of the Saints, can help us understand more fully how



truly devoted they were despite all their suffering, trials & tribulations and how they continued to preserve with continued practice and patience.

St. John Paul II prayed for hours each day, interceding for the world and drawing closer and closer in his relationship with God. Prayer helped sustain him during his early life in Nazi-occupied Poland. It continued to remain the central part of his life, especially while he was the Pope.

St. John Paul II wrote a lot about prayer and in seeking a deeper, closer relationship with God.

"If you really wish to follow Christ, if you want your love for him to grow and last, then you must be faithful to prayer. It is the key to the vitality of your life in Christ. Without prayer, your faith and love will die. If you are constant in daily prayer and in the Sunday celebration of Mass, your love for Jesus will increase. And your heart will know deep joy and peace, such as the world could never give."
