Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary is

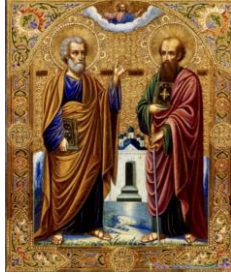

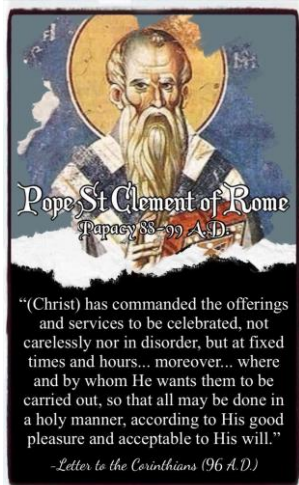

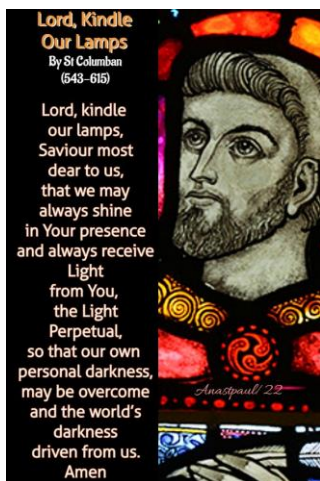
