

<u>Ideas for a Delicious Plant-Based Meal</u> <u>Vegan Pumpkin Nuggets</u>

½ Hokkaido pumpkin (2 cups/280g pumpkin chunks) 1 tablespoon olive oil for the pan

Ingredients for the batter

½ cup all-purpose flour

1/2 cup water

½ teaspoon salt

Ingredients for the breading

½ cup panko flakes

½ cup fine breadcrumbs

½ teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon paprika powder

1 teaspoon dried rosemary

Instructions

Cut the pumpkin in half. Spoon out the seeds. Cut them into rings. Peel them using a veggie peeler. Then cut them into chunks.

Boil the pumpkin in a pot with water until they get softer (approx. 10 mins), they shouldn't be mushy. Strain and drain the boiled pumpkin bites. Let them cool off.

Mix the ingredients for the batter in own bowl.

In another bow, mix the ingredients for the breading.

Dip them into the batter first, then toss them in the breadcrumbs until they are evenly coated.

Heat a pan with olive oil, and pan-fry the pumpkin pieces over medium to high heat on each side until They are nicely golden brown. Let them cool off a bit before serving. Serves 2.

FAITH CORNER – THE LIVES OF THE SAINTS

Saint Angela was born to a family of farmers in Lombard, Italy the fifth of six children. While still exceptionally young, she witnessed the death of her older brother and three sisters, and shortly thereafter, both her parents. She and her surviving sister became wards of her uncle.

Not much is known concerning the rest of her childhood except that she was a pious child and was fascinated by stories of Saint Ursula. The deaths of her family members obviously came as a great shock to her. One day, she received a vision from her beloved older sister, and decided to consecrate her life to God. She followed a life of extreme austerity, modeled after the life of Saint Francis, taking no possessions as her own and living entirely as vegetarian--consuming only bread, vegetables and water. After the death of her uncle, when Angela was but twenty-two of age she took it upon herself to educate the poorer children of the town. She gathered together the little girls of the neighborhood and gave them regular and systematic instructions. This work that started humbly began to flourish, and soon, the leading families of the town brought their daughters to her for education. Her works of charity became widely recognized throughout the city. Angela recognized that these young women of poverty would be forced into the most menial of services, prostitution, or begging. To remedy this, she began by setting up refuges for these poor women who had not found husbands. Then she created homes for them, run by older matrons, often widows, to protect them. Finally, she made sure that neither the younger women were exploited sexually, nor the older women exploited financially. Although Angela had her ardent supporters, she also had many enemies. Through all her trials, she held firm in her commitment to educate and protect the young women of her city as if they were her own. In 1535, she, and twenty-eight other young women, consecrated themselves to the service of God. She placed these women under the protective blessing of Saint Ursula, the patroness of medieval universities who was venerated as a leader of women. Hence evolved the name Ursulines for her followers, the name under which her Order was born. Going about in her Franciscan habit, she became a well-respected figure, known for her compassion toward all in need, her belief in non-violence toward all creatures, her physical austerities, her devout religious convictions, and her life saving assistance to all women in need.
