Christus Dominus_(Christ The Lord) is the Decree on the Pastoral Office of Bishops in the Church which was promulgated on October 28, 1965. The bishops who are united in one "college or body" have been "designated by the Holy Spirit to take the place of the apostles as pastors of souls and, together with the Supreme Pontiff and subject to his authority, they are commissioned to perpetuate

the work of Christ" (n2). This Decree focuses on the practical applications of the council's teaching on the office of bishops The council recommends that the Roman Curia be "re-organized and modernized" with membership representative of the universal church including more diocesan bishops and more frequent recourse to the advice of the laity (n10).

A bishop needs to be solicitous of the welfare of his priests, spiritually, intellectually and materially. Furthermore in order to provide for the welfare of the faithful he must " try to keep himself informed of their needs in the social circumstances in which they live" (n16). The council recommends every diocese have a special pastoral council presided over by the bishop in which clergy, religious and laity specially chosen for the purpose participate. These councils are to be "a useful medium for the bishop, not only for diocesan administration, but also for pastoral activity" (n27). In the final chapter of the decree, the council fathers express hope that the synods and episcopal councils "flourish with renewed vigor so that the growth of religion and the maintenance of discipline in the various churches may increasingly be more effectively provided for in accordance with the need of the times"(n36).
