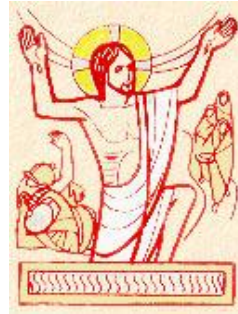

EASTER SEASON

The Season of Easter is 50 days long and concludes with the celebration of Pentecost on the May 23rd & 24th weekend.



In many ways, the Church celebrates this entire season as one Great Feast day (The Ordo- the Liturgical Calendar of Canada). The season begins with the Octave of Easter, *8 days of solemnity*. Our Gospel readings for the 2nd and 3rd Sundays are post-resurrection stories of Jesus. The 4th Sunday is known as Good Shepherd Sunday with the Gospel taken from John 10. Good Shepherd Sunday also emphasizes the importance of vocations to the priesthood and the religious life. The Gospel for the 5th and 6th Sundays is taken from the Gospel of John. The following is the celebration of the Ascension of the Lord, and the season concludes with the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

 Throughout this season, the liturgical colour is white and the Paschal candle is prominently displayed in the front of the altar.

 Throughout this season, our Easter proclamation is ***"Christ is risen, He has risen indeed! Alleluia!!"***
