**EASTER SEASON** The Season of Easter is 50 days long and concludes with the celebration of Pentecost on the June 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> weekend. In many ways, the Church celebrates this entire season as one Great Feast day (The Ordo- the Liturgical Calendar of Canada). The season begins with the Octave of Easter, *8 days of solemnity*. Our Gospel readings for the 2<sup>nd</sup> an 3<sup>rd</sup> Sundays are post-resurrection stories of Jesus. The 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday is known as Good Shepherd Sunday with the Gospel taken from John 10. This Sunday, there is also an emphasis on the promotion of vocations to the priesthood and the religious life. The Gospel for the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Sundays are taken from the Gospel of John. The following is the celebration of the Ascension of the Lord, and the season concludes with the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.



*Throughout this season, the liturgical colour is white and the Paschal candle is prominently displayed in the front of the altar.*



*Throughout this season, our Easter proclamation is “**Christ is risen, He has risen indeed! Alleluia!!**”*
