## **FAITH'S CORNER**

Saint Gilbert was born in Lincolnshire, England where he received a religious education. He felt a calling and a commitment to live a religious life, and was subsequently ordained priest by the Bishop of London. Gilbert would teach the poor in a free school and then give his entire stipend away to the indigent. Those who followed him grew in sanctity, and as their numbers increased, Gilbert

framed a set of Rules for these young men and women to help direct their lives. Gilbert sustained himself solely on vegetarian foods—roots and pulse—and always shared a plate of food from each of his meals with the poor. Initially, he fashioned the patterns of religious life for himself and his followers after the Rule of Saint Benedict. Saint Gilbert and the sisters incurred the displeasure of King Henry II (reign 1154-1189), who accused them of assisting Thomas Becket in his escape to France. Gilbert was summoned by the King to answer questions, but subsequently obtained a pardon from all charges. By the time of his death, there were over fifteen hundred members within his monasteries—all living by the Rule he envisioned for those seeking a life of holiness and dedication. Gilbert chose to live in simplicity, in sacrifice for others, and in never taking more from this earth than he needed.
