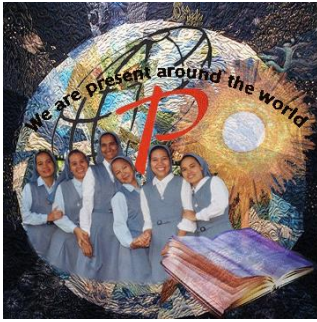
### **Week of Prayer for Christian Unity: January 18 to 25, 2016**

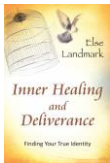
