DAYS OF PENANCE DURING LENT – The time of Lent and all Fridays of the year are, throughout the universal Church, day and times especially appropriate for spiritual exercises; penitential liturgies; pilgrimages as signs of penance; voluntary self-denial, such as fasting and almsgiving. Abstinence from meat is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. All persons who have completed their fourteenth year are bound by the law of abstinence. All adults (eighteen years of older) are bound by the law of fast up to the beginning of their sixtieth year. Pastors and parents are to see to it that minors who are not bound by a law of fast of abstinence are educated nevertheless in an authentic sense of penance. It is for the conference of bishops to determine more precisely the observances of fast and abstinence and to substitute in whole or in part for fast or abstinence other forms of penance, especially works of charity and exercises of piety and missionary works.

ALL DAY ADORATION ON FRIDAY'S DURING LENT

Starting the First Friday of Lent, and every following Friday Mar 10, 17, 24 & 31 there will be all day Adoration. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament using the Tabernacle Monstrance will be exposed after the 8:00am mass. Simple reposition will take place at 6:50pm and Stations of Cross will follow at 7:00pm lead by Fr. Donatello. Come and pray on Fridays and spend some time with Jesus in solitude with meditative music playing in the background.
