## **SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS**



### **THE SACRAMENT OF THE GREAT GIFTS TO OUR PRIESTS – What this Sacrament Is and Does for Our Priests**

**What is the Sacrament of Holy Orders? Holy Orders is the Sacrament by which the office of bishop, priest, or deacon is conferred on certain men together with its powers and graces.** The outward sign of the Sacrament of Holy

Orders is the laying on of hands and the accompanying prayer by the bishop along with other ceremonies.
