Ideas for a Delicious Plant-Based Meal Sweet Potato & Brussels Sprouts Gratin

Ingredients

1 lb brussels sprouts, thinly sliced

1 large sweet potato, thinly sliced (peeling optional)

½ cup unsweetened oat milk

1 cup vegetable broth

1 ½. tbsp dijon mustard

2 tbsp nutritional yeast

1 tsp dark maple syrup

1 tsp sea salt

½ tsp freshly ground black pepper

1 cup panko bread crumbs or homemade bread crumbs

34 cup finely chopped walnuts or pecans

2 cloves garlic, minced

2 tbsp extra virgin olive oil

1 tsp sea salt

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350°.

Place the sliced brussels sprouts and sweet potato in a baking dish.

In a mixing bowl, combine the oat milk, broth, mustard, nutritional yeast, maple syrup, salt and pepper. Stir well, then pour over the vegetables.

In another bowl, combine the bread crumbs, nuts, garlic, olive oil and salt. Stir well.

Pour the mixture over the veggies then spread evenly.

Bake for 40 minutes, rotating the baking dish halfway through. Serves 4 to 6 people.

FAITH CORNER – THE LIVES OF THE SAINTS

<u>Saint Dorotheus the Theban</u> – Saint Dorotheus was an exceptionally holy individual who joined a monastery to live and pray amongst the other monks of the Egyptian desert. He remained for several years in the religious community until he had acquired the skills necessary for one to

live a hermitic life. Eventually, he felt the time was right to leave the monastery and live a contemplative, meditative life alone in the desert nine miles from Alexandria, Egypt. By this time, he recognized the value of hard, physical labor and chose to spend a good part of his life carrying stones to build hermitages for other hermits. His income was a meager, only that earned by weaving baskets, and he used this to buy his daily rations of six ounces of bread and a few herbs—his sole nourishment. Even when Dorotheus reached old age, he continued a life of strenuous work. He was dedicated to the welfare of the needy. He prayed for the infirm, and was a deeply religious man who contemplated God. Once when he saw a snake in a well from which he was about to take drinking water, he hesitated only slightly prior to dipping his cup. Then, making the sign of the cross over his cup, he swallowed the contents saying; "In the presence of the cross of Jesus, the devil loses his power." Saint Dorotheus possessed complete faith in the love of God. He sought to live as a vegetarian so as to share God's compassionate, gentle mercy with all beings.
