

STEWARDSHIP SUNDAY – SEPTEMBER 20TH, 2020

Cardinal Thomas Collins, Archbishop of Toronto, has announced the institution of Stewardship Sunday across the archdiocese on the 25th Sunday of Ordinary Time. The first Stewardship Sunday will take place on September 20, 2020. Cardinal Thomas Collins' Pastoral Letter on Stewardship is organized into four sections, with the first being "The Meaning of Stewardship" in the Christian Life. This section explores the reality that we are invited by God

to be good stewards of His gifts. "If we truly have the spirit of stewardship, we will not let God's gifts go to waste, and we will not selfishly cling to them, but use them graciously to serve others, and in doing so give glory to God."
